WHEREAS, state employees serve six million Missourians every day with a wide range of services; and


WHEREAS, the 2015 observance of Missouri State Employees' Recognition Day provides a special time to express our appreciation and gratitude to our state employees.


MISSOURI STATE EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION DAY
