

**BOARD OF FUND COMMISSIONERS
MINUTES OF MEETING**

July 12, 2018

Pursuant to public notice previously provided by the Office of Administration, Governor Parson called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM. Call of roll indicated that the following members of the Board were present:

Governor Michael Parson – President
Treasurer Eric Schmitt - Secretary – via Conference Call
Lieutenant Governor Mike Kehoe – Member
Attorney General Josh Hawley – Member
Commissioner Sarah Steelman – Member – via Conference Call

A waiver and consent to hold the meeting was circulated for signature.

Governor Parson stated that the Board of Fund Commissioners staff had previously circulated the minutes of the last meeting. Governor Parson asked for approval of the minutes of the last meeting which was held on July 11, 2017. Lieutenant Governor Kehoe moved for the adoption of the minutes. Attorney General Hawley seconded the motion. Motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Governor Parson stated the first item on the agenda was a resolution authorizing the Fiscal Year 2019 transfers to sinking fund and payments of principal and interest for bonds currently outstanding. Governor Parson asked Stacy Neal to brief the board. Stacy explained that approval of the resolution would authorize the Office of Administration to make all the payments and transfers related to House Bill 1 appropriations. This includes payments for principal and interest in Fiscal Year 2019 and would also transfer all debt service to the sinking funds for Fiscal Year 2020 payments pursuant to the Constitution.

With no further discussion or questions, Attorney General Hawley motioned to approve; Lieutenant Governor Kehoe seconded the motion. Motion was carried with the following vote:
