DEFINITION	
<i>Name</i>	Navigation
<i>Description</i>	Navigation refers to the method used to find information within a Web site. A Web site's navigation scheme and features should allow users to find and access information effectively and efficiently.
<i>Rationale</i>	Consistent and effective navigation design enables users to move around easily and find what they need on all agency Web sites.
<i>Benefits</i>	<p>An effective navigation scheme will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be easily learned so that your readers don't get lost • remain consistent throughout the Web site • offer alternative choices for navigation • offer clear and understandable labels • support visitors' goals and behaviors

COMPLIANCE DETAIL	
<i>State the Guideline, Standard or Legislation</i>	<p>The most common navigation element is a menu of some kind, but navigation elements can also include inline links, tables of contents, site maps, search engines, etc.</p> <p><u>Common Navigation Elements on State Web Sites</u></p> <p>1. <u>Link to State Home Page</u> <u>Standard:</u> Each agency home page must have a link to the State of Missouri home page (http://www.mo.gov). <u>Guideline:</u> The users should not have to scroll to find the link. The link to the state home page should be easily identified in the main navigation of the agency home page, either with a graphic or prominent text. A link to the State home page:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • will allow users to navigate smoothly between the state portal and agency pages.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> identifies your agency as part of the State of Missouri Web. <p>2. <i>Link to Search Page</i> <u>Standard:</u> Your home page should allow searching through the state search engine as well as a form to search the agency pages. <u>Guideline:</u> Your search page should be customized to reflect your site design and default to search your site first.</p> <p>For further information on navigation usability, types of navigation, as well as minimum recommendations for what to include in global navigation, see Branding - Usability - Navigation document.</p> <p>For other related information, see Branding - Usability - Layout document.</p>
