## **DEPARTMENT SUMMARY**

The Fiscal Year 2018 budget provides \$154.7 million for the Department of Conservation to support its mission to protect and manage the fish and wildlife resources of Missouri. In 1976, Missouri voters endorsed a measure authorizing a one-eighth of one-cent sales tax to provide for conservation services. This dedicated funding source has helped foster abundant fish, wildlife, forestry, and water resources for generations of Missourians.
