Fiscal Year 2021 appropriations include funds for the following items:

- \$2,600,000 Basic Civil Legal Services Fund to allow for disbursement of the Tort Victims Compensation Fund collections to legal aid offices.
- \$300,000 for circuit court realignment. *(\$300,000 expenditure restriction)*
- \$75,113 and one staff for an additional associate circuit court judge for the 19th judicial circuit in Cole County, pursuant to SB 871 (2018).

Vetoed in HB 2012 (Judiciary) include:

- (\$93,507) for a \$.06 increase in the mileage reimbursement rate, including (\$70,937) General Revenue.

Fiscal Year 2021 appropriations include reductions from the Fiscal Year 2020 core appropriation levels for the following items:

- (\$2,995,616) reduction from treatment court resources.
- (\$973,768) reduction from Judiciary education and training.
- (\$250,000) reduction of one-time expenditures for a St. Louis City diversion program.

*The italicized expenditure restrictions were put in place on July 1, 2020.*
