NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

JEFFERSON CITY, MO – On February 25, 2022, the Judicial Redistricting Commission will hold a public hearing where the general public may offer comments regarding the Commission's charge to draw new Senate district lines.

The public hearing will be held from 10:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., if necessary, at Room 500 of the Harry S. Truman State Office Building, located at 301 W. High St. in Jefferson City. The purpose of the public hearing is to supplement any previous public comments received by the Senate Independent Bipartisan Citizens Commission (SIBCC). Anyone who previously provided public comment to the SIBCC should only provide additional public comment at this public hearing if they have new information or materials to present.

A sign-in sheet will be available 30 minutes prior to the public hearing. The sign-in sheet will determine the order of speakers, and there will be a 10 minute time limit for each speaker. The Commission will only receive public comments in-person at the hearing or by online submission at oa.mo.gov/judicial-public-testimony. Any written materials or proposed maps should be submitted electronically in advance of the public hearing through the website's online comment portal.
