Description	Browser Shots is a free screen capture service that lets you submit Web site URLs and returns screen captures of your Web pages as viewed in different browsers, operating systems and screen resolutions.		
Rationale	Most Web developers do not have the hardware/software capability available to test in a wide variety of environments and configurations. Frequently, Web pages will look different across different browsers, operating systems and screen resolutions. Browser Shots provides a centralized point to test your design and ensure cross-browser compatibility.		
Benefits	Browser Shots allows you to: • see your Web design in several different browsers and in different resolutions, • use a bank of volunteer testing machines remotely to test your website, and • save time and money.

List Undesirable aspects	- When submitting a URL, it is then placed in a queue to be processed in the order in which it was received. It will give you an approximate status on completion, but it will usually not be immediately. - This is not the right solution for you if you need to do some quick testing. - It will not allow you to pick which combination of operating systems to test with which browsers. - It does not allow you to test in older versions of browsers. - It is limited to a non-authenticated, non-transactional or non-secure Web site.
