POSITION GUIDE FOR SOCIAL SECURITY COVERAGE

For use in Social Security determinations, SSA uses the Core Data Codes as issued by DESE.

The attached document is Exhibit 10 of DESE's Core Data Manual and is an explanation of Courses, along with DESE certificate requirements that School districts use for reporting employee activity.

All courses on pages 1 through 14 (ending with the "19 Special Education" section) are included as "Teacher" positions.

Courses beginning with "88", starting on page 15, are the start of the Non Teaching Assignments as categorized by DESE. In that description it states: "For non-teaching assignments (88xxxx) the third digit from the left generally matches the first digit of the position code (e.g., assignment 885200 and position code 50)."

All position codes 10 through 60 are excluded from Social Security coverage.

For Position Codes 70, 80, and 90, districts should refer to the Requirements column to assess Social Security coverage. If a DESE issued Certificate of License to Teach is required, then the position is excluded from Social Security.

If a school district employee occupies a position excluded from Social Security coverage, then any compensation received by the employee for extra duties performed or additional positions occupied while in that position, will be excluded from Social Security coverage. Conversely, if the employee occupies a position covered by Social Security, then any compensation received by the employee for extra duties performed while in that position, or for any additional positions occupied by the employee with the same employer, that compensation will be covered by Social Security.

Note: Position Code #887800 *Parent Educator* references requirements on "Exhibit 8" of the DESE Core Data Manual. Exhibit 8 shows educational degrees as requirements for this position, and a certificate of license to teach is not required. Because the position does not require a teaching certificate, it is covered for Social Security.
