Title: Enhancements for USAPlants Application

Description: The Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA) requires enhancements to the MDA's existing USAPlants module which is part of their existing National Agribusiness Technology Center (NATC) AgraGuard applications/system which are maintained under Missouri Contract CT160745001. The required enhancements include enabling the inspection, complaint, and enforcement modules for Feed, Seed, and Treated Timber and configuring and enabling the disconnected inspection application so that MDA inspectors can complete inspections while disconnected from the Internet. The MDA will also require ongoing maintenance and support for the products resulting from the above referenced enhancements. The National Agribusiness Technology Center (NATC) is the holder of the AgraGuard application licenses for the products licensed for use by the MDA and has named Computer Aid, Inc. (CAI) as the only vendor certified and approved by the NATC to provide maintenance, technical support, and enhancements for their AgraGuard applications, including USAPlants. As the required enhancement services, technical support, and maintenance are available only from CAI, the services represent proprietary requirements that meet the criteria of a single feasible source under RSMo 34.044 and the State is pursuing the acquisition of the services via a Single Feasible Source (SFS) procurement.
