Title: Pharmacy System Expansion – Intellidocs System Component

Description: The Office of Administration, Information Technology Services Division (ITSD) requires expansion of the existing pharmacy system solution utilized by the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to include an Intellidocs system component. The Meta Intellidocs component seamlessly integrates with other Meta components that the state has acquired. The Intellidocs system module is an electronic clinical documentation solution that is required by ITSD-DMH to complete their fully integrated Electronic Health Record (EHR) system with other Meta components already acquired – the Pharmacy Management System along with the Computerized Physician Order Entry (CPOE) module and the Electronic Medication Administration Record (eMAR) module – with a shared database. The Meta Intellidocs module and shared database is proprietary and only available from Meta and is required in order to provide a seamlessly integrated Pharmacy Management EHR solution. The integrated solution is required in order to provide integrated technological capability, functionality and security. Since Meta has indicated that they will not permit other applications to contribute to the underlying database, the alternative of procuring and implementing a new fully functional EHR is not feasible versus upgrading ITSD’s system to include the Intellidocs module.

As a result, this represents a proprietary requirement that meets the criteria as a single feasible source under RSMo 34.044 and the State is pursuing this acquisition as a Single Feasible Source.
