

## Single Feasible Source Purchase

**Title:** Services for Low-Income Native Americans

**Description:** To provide health, welfare, and cultural services to Native American individuals and families in our communities; to promote the affiliation of Native Americans of all tribes into an educational, civic, and cultural organization; to establish and operate an Indian Center; to promote fellowship among Native Americans of all tribes living in the Springfield and Kansas City areas; to simulate the natural integration of Native Americans into the community life of the Indian people; to encourage artistic and avocational pursuits by Native Americans; and to preserve and foster Native American arts, crafts, and cultural values.

The Southwest Missouri Indian Center and the Kansas City Indian Center are considered single feasible sources because they are the only Native American Centers in Springfield and Kansas City recognized in accordance with the USDA Native American Emphasis Program. Additionally, based on previous attempted competitive solicitations, it has been determined that the Southwest Missouri Indian Center is the only entity that provides necessary services in Springfield and the Kansas City Indian Center is the only entity that provides necessary services in Kansas City.
