**Bidders and Bronze Door Restoration Specialists are hereby informed of the following modifications:**

### **SPECIFICATION CHANGES:**

1. Section 005415 – Request for Pre-Qualification Bronze Door Restoration Specialist
  - a. REVISE the first sentence in Section **3.1 Overview** as follows: “Bronze Door Restoration Specialists are required to be pre-qualified in order to perform any work on the project as a subcontractor.”
  - b. REVISE the second sentence in Section **3.3.1 Available Points** as follows: “A minimum of 800 points is required to qualify for the list of approved Bronze Door Restoration Specialists for this project.”

### **GENERAL:**

1. Submission of Statements of Qualifications deadline remain until 1:30 PM CST, Friday, September 22, 2023. Statements of Qualifications shall be delivered to the address provided on the first page of the Request for Pre-Qualification by the date and time specified or as modified via addendum only. Late proposals will not be considered. The Respondent is solely responsible for submitting a response on time. It is the responsibility of the Respondent to ensure that submissions are received by the deadline. All Submissions should follow the Format outlined in Section 3.5.1 and include all required information as defined in Section 4.0 of the Request for Pre- Qualifications.
2. **All companies who are planning on bidding as a General Contractor:**

In order to be awarded a contract, any bidder that operates as a legal entity in the State of Missouri must be appropriately registered with the Missouri Secretary of State’s office, and such registration must be active and in good standing. If the successful bidder is doing business in the State of Missouri under a fictitious name, the bidder must have a current Registration of Fictitious Name. If the bidder is an entity formed in another State, the bidder must have a Certificate of Authority to do business in Missouri. The Owner will typically ascertain the bidder’s standing with the Missouri Secretary of State from the information available on the Secretary of State’s website. However, the Owner may, at its discretion, request proof of compliance with this paragraph from the selected bidder prior to award of a contract. The bidder shall provide a certified copy of its Certificate of Good Standing, Certificate of Authority and/or Registration of Fictitious name to the Owner upon request. If the bidder fails to provide such information upon request, the Owner shall not award a contract to the Respondent, and the Owner will not be under any further obligation to the Respondent.

Bids must be submitted through the MissouriBUYS statewide eProcurement system (<https://www.missouribuys.mo.gov/>) in accordance with the instructions for that system. The Owner shall only accept bids submitted through MissouriBUYS. Bids received by the Owner through any other means, including hard copies, shall not be considered and will be discarded by the Owner unopened. See Bid Specifications, Section 002113 – Instructions to Bidders, Section 7.0 for further information.
