Security personnel conduct 100% ID checks at all gates of entry. Persons aged 16 years and older must present a state or federally issued picture identification. Persons not possessing a Department of Defense (DoD) issued ID card or an approved Federal employee must have a valid reason to access Whiteman AFB, must undergo a criminal history background screening, and be issued a Whiteman AFB pass. Person(s) operating a vehicle are required to have in possession a current driver license, proof of current vehicle insurance and current vehicle registration.

IDENTIFICATION

Persons possessing a DoD or Federal issued identification card or a Whiteman AFB issued pass must present this document at the gate of entry before access is granted. All persons and vehicles are subject to random inspection prior to gaining access. Personnel requesting access to Whiteman AFB for any reason must be in possession of a REAL ID. REAL ID is a federal security credential added to state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards, marked by a gold star in the upper-right hand corner. Once in effect, base security will no longer accept state-issued identification from visitors that does not meet the new federal security standards established by the REAL ID Act. Enhanced Driver's Licenses (EDLs) are state-issued driver's licenses, that also meet REAL ID standards. EDLs are marked as "Enhanced Driver License" and bear a small red, white, and blue United States flag logo on the front of the identification card.

Visitors not meeting the REAL ID Act requirements can provide one of these authorized alternative forms of ID with their non-compliant REAL ID:

- Birth certificate with a raised seal and social security card
- U.S. or foreign Passport/Passport Card
- Veteran's Health Identification Card
- Transportation Worker Identification Card

Additionally, visitors can request an extension on non-compliant REAL IDs through the WAFB Visitor Center. Requests are subject to 509 BW/CC or designee approval and may take up to 30 days to process.

All visitors who fail to provide proper identification in compliance with REAL ID guidance will be denied entry to the installation.
