- 4. Section 329200 Non-native Turf
 - A. Questions:
 - a. What is the fertilizer application rate? Per manufacturer recommendations.
 - b. Is broadcasting method acceptable for seeding/fertilizing as long as no high winds? Yes.
 - c. Is the Bonded Fiber matrix intended to be applied at the manufacturers recommended rate? Yes.
 - d. Is it acceptable to do all of the permanent stabilization with seeding or are there specific areas that this project is wanting to utilize sod on? I saw wording for sodding in the specifications and plans. We would prefer to utilize only seeding if possible. Seeding is acceptable.
 - e. Estimated quantity for seeding? *Contractor is responsible for determining quantities*.
 - f. Is there a water source onsite? Yes, water can be sourced from one of the existing hydrants. Contractor shall coordinate with MSP staff.
 - g. Is pesticide required with seed application? Only if necessary.
 - h. In Section 329200 it has wording to be a member of good standing of either the professional landcare network or the American nursery and landscape association. Will this be a requirement for this project? Yes.
 - i. In Section 329200 it states to have a pesticide applicator that is state licensed. Will this be a requirement for this project? Yes, if needed.

5. Section 312500 - Erosion and Sedimentation Controls

A. Questions:

- a. For phase 2 of the erosion control plans I see in the notes it mentions silt fence in the specifications it says this product will not be utilized. Is the topsoil stockpile area intended to be wrapped in straw wattles instead of silt fence? Yes, straw wattles per C-602.
- b. Estimated quantities for Straw wattles? *Contractor is responsible for determining quantities.*
- c. Is 12" diameter the correct size for the straw wattles? Yes.
- d. Is class A biodegradable logs (312500 specifications-rice or wheat straw fibers) be acceptable for use of areas calling for straw wattles? Yes.
- e. Are there any area inlets or other drain inlets that will need inlet protection on this project? *No.*

D. Prevailing Wage

MISSOURI PREVAILING WAGE LAW (Sections 290.210 to 290.340, RSMo): The Contractor shall pay not less than the specified hourly rate of wages, as set out in the wage order attached to and made part of the specifications for work under this contract, to all workers performing work under the contract, in accordance with sections 290.210 to 290.340, RSMo.
