## Local PPE Manufacturers Supply Channel QVL— Awarded Contracts—CC211086001 thru CC211086027

**Great News!** Your entity is now eligible to purchase needed PPE items from the state's **NEW** Statewide **Local PPE Manufacturers** Supply Channel Qualified Vendor List. The contract can be found at the following link: <https://archive.ia.mo.gov/purch/oa/cc211086.pdf>. On March 30, 2021, we awarded 25 contracts to Missouri manufacturers of various PPE products and 2 contracts to Kansas PPE manufacturers. Awards were only made to direct manufacturers of specified PPE items (specs provided by Mo Dept of Health and Senior Services) manufactured within a 250 mile radius of Jefferson City so that if the state (or Cooperative Procurement Program members) urgently needed to drive up and back to get the products in a day trip, they could. The statewide contract notice lists the awards by line item and by manufacturer and provides instructions to agencies for seeking quick quotes from at least three of the vendors awarded the needed line item if possible. Items on the contracts include various masks, gowns, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, protective barriers, face shields, shoe covers and short-term warehousing. Please refer to the statewide notice for specific product awards and ordering details.
