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Using Missouri's Statewide Contracts

Cooperative Procurement Program members can benefit from the state's purchasing power by using our competitively-bid statewide contracts that are ready for immediate use.



Members can easily locate and quickly purchase routinely-used commodities, services, and technology from over 400 existing statewide contracts (in over 100 contract categories) to meet their entity's needs faster than bidding themselves.

Some of Purchasing's statewide contracts are adopted contracts established by other lead government entities under a public cooperative such as NASPO ValuePoint.

With Statewide Contracts, since the procurement process has already been

What is MissouriBUYS ?

Statewide eProcurement System

MissouriBUYS is the State of Missouri's new web-based statewide eProcurement system (<https://missouribuys.mo.gov>) implemented with its contractor, Perfect Commerce (a PROACTIS Company), using their WebProcure application. MissouriBUYS is a user-friendly, one-stop shop for procurements by the state and can be used by Missouri local government agencies and political subdivisions when fully implemented.

The Division of Purchasing uses MissouriBUYS to post all of its solicitations on the Bid Board, register its vendors online, automatically notify registered vendors of bid opportunities, accept online and hard copy bids, post contracts on the Contract Board, and set up contracts as catalogs for online shopping and checkout by agencies.

The State required its eProcurement system contractor to include local governmental entities

at no cost in the state's license. So when fully implemented, these entities will be invited to use MissouriBUYS for posting bids, for email notifications of bid opportunities to registered vendors, for accepting online bids, and for posting contracts all at no charge to the entities.

The first phase of rollout of MissouriBUYS to local government/political subdivision entities has begun with the recent launch of the MissouriBUYS Bid Locator Tool on the Bid Board. The new Bid Locator Tool is a search engine that crawls Missouri federal, state, and local government purchasing websites helping vendors find additional public sector bid opportunities without having to search multiple sites. Vendors (and others) can find and select the bid that interests them and be redirected to the governmental entity's bid landing page for actual bid details. Missouri State Agency for Surplus Property

Did you know you can receive Surplus Property from the state? The Missouri State Agency for Surplus Property (MOSASP), which is housed in the Office of Administration's Division of General Services, is responsible for the transfer and disposal of state surplus property and distribution of excess federal property to eligible entities. Surplus Property receives federal surplus property and transfers the property to eligible entities (i.e. state agencies, cities, counties, schools, etc.)
