Division of Purchasing Team Section Names Have Changed



Effective July 1, 2020, the Division of Purchasing went back to having three sections based on procurement type — Commodities, Information Technology (IT), and Services. Rather than having a single section focused on statewide contracts, Purchasing is increasing focus within each section on statewide contracts. The focus will be on timely replacements and identifying and filling gaps through a strategic, big picture analysis. COVID-19 Procurement Challenges

situation is still producing The COVID-19 extraordinary procurement challenges - not only supply shortages of critically-needed Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) but also unfamiliar market conditions. Most contractors and local suppliers are low on or out of supply. New business startups with no history and/or risky payment terms still pose a procurement risk and need to be properly vetted. Limited US production has created significant dependency on offshore markets. Product deliveries from overseas are sometimes slowed by customs.

Some of the lessons that have been learned by Division of Purchasing during the COVID-19 while maneuvering through unchartered procurement waters to procure vital products and services include:

- Entities need to establish and maintain up-to -date emergency response processes.
- 2. Communications matter.

awarded Purchasing recently contract CS202323001-011 for **Community-Based** State **COVID-19 Testing**' which can be used by state and local entities.

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- 3. Buyers need to start earlier with reordering routinely-used or critically-needed products; be sure to have adequate reserve on hand to allow reorder/delivery time.
- 4. Have multiple sources of supply.
- 5. Purchase responsibly because you are still held accountable for your procurements.
- 6. Engage your subject matter experts to help quickly validate whether products being considered for purchase are acceptable so you can make quicker ordering decisions.
- 7. Don't blindly order from unknown vendors vet vendors and their terms of sale. Get agreement to your terms if possible.
